

Antipode Foundation International Workshop Awards, 2020

*Please submit a **four-page** application to Andy Kent (antipode@live.co.uk)
before/on 30th April 2020.*

Page one should contain the **title of the event** and its **organisers' details** (names, position, department, institution/organisation, city, zip/postcode, country, phone number and e-mail address).

All applicants must read and acknowledge the Foundation's transparency notice (<https://antipodeonline.org/transparency-notice/>). This notice sets out how we use and protect your personal information. In order to consider your application we must send it to our Trustees, some of whom are based outside the European Economic Area (EEA) including in jurisdictions where personal data may not have the same protection as within the EEA. This is a necessary part of the application process. By submitting your application you agree to it being sent to our Trustees outside the EEA in accordance with the transparency notice.

Outline the event itself on pages two and three. Here you might cover: location(s) and date(s), **participants and planned activities**, and rationale; **ambitions**, that is, how the event will contribute to radical geographic scholarship and practice; and **outcomes, dissemination and legacies**, or, the expected "afterlives" of the event.

Please be as concise and direct as possible, *using no more than 1,500 words*; we'd discourage references, endnotes and footnotes, encouraging "telegraphic" descriptions rather than literature reviews and the like.

Page four should sketch-out the **budget**—how much money is needed, how you intend to spend it, and what **co-funding** has been secured.

Please use a single column of 10/12 point text, in Times or similar font, single-spaced, with margins of 2cm
